Egypt: A Type of the World System

Pharaoh: A Type of Satan, the god of this world.

Is. 14:12-15; Ex. 5:2

Israel: A Type of the Church

Delivered from the bondage of the world.

Led on a pilgrim journey.

Protected by God.

Moses: A Type of Christ

The Deliverer of God's people; A Prophet

The Passover Ch. 12: A Picture of Christ's work on the Cross

In every aspect it is a Picture of the work of Jesus Christ on the Cross.

Crossing of the Sea Ch. 13,14: A Picture of the Resurrection

The crossing of the sea delivers the believer from this present evil world. It is God's judgment on evil – the Egyptians.

Manna Ch. 16: A Picture of Christ – the Bread of Life

Jesus says. *I am the Bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry.*
(Joh. 6:35)

The Rock Ch. 17: A Picture of the smitten Christ and the Holy Spirit

Through Christ, who was nailed on the cross, smitten by his enemies, broken, - the Holy Spirit was given to us. Water is a symbol of the H.S.

Amalekites Ch. 17: A Picture of the Flesh, opposing believer on his journey with God

The Amalekites were fighting the Israelites; Moses, Aaron and Hur, went up on a mountain side to seek God's strength. Moses lifts up his hands, supported by Aaron and Hur. And as long as he has his hands up in the air, the Israelites win. (Ex. 17)
